RULES & REGULATIONS

- All players taking part in the competition will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the competition events are to be conducted.
- For their own safety, participants are advised to seek medical clearance from healthcare professionals prior to competing in the games. The organisers shall not be held responsible for any personal health or medical-related incidents.
- All players are required to bring along their photo identification documents, and verification of NTUC membership will be conducted via the MyNTUC app on the day of the tournament.
- The term “Organising Committee” shall refer to both U Live and Orchid Bowl.
- Once entries have been accepted, no replacement or substitution of players will be entertained. However, the Organising Committee reserves the right, at its discretion, to accept such changes if deemed necessary and with valid reasons, provided no games have been played by the player(s) in question.
- The decision of the Organising Committee shall be deemed final.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations prior to the commencement of the event.

REGISTRATION

1. Eligibility:

- Participation in the National Day Fun Bowl 2025 is open to all, regardless of whether they are forming their own teams independently or representing Unions and Associations. Each team **must** include at least one U Live member (NTUC member aged 55 and above).

2. Team Composition and Entrance Fee:

- Each team shall comprise four bowlers and can be a mixed team. Each female bowler in a team will receive a 7-pin handicap per game, which will be added to the team's total score. Any submission of more than the stipulated number of teams must seek the approval from the Organising Committee.
- The registration fee is \$240.00 per team of four (4) bowlers for NTUC Members, and \$280.00 per team for the General Public.
- NTUC Trade-Affiliated Unions and Associations: Utilisation of the Union Support Scheme (USS) is subject to the availability of funds and the discretion of the Organising Committee.
- For each team registration, the team will be entitled to up to six (6) training sessions at Orchid Bowl, held on Mondays from 7 July 2025, between 7:00 PM and 10:00 PM, with the final session on Monday, 11 August 2025, depending on the day of sign-up. **Please note that no make-up sessions will be provided for any missed sessions.*

FORMAT OF PLAY

1. The National Day Fun Bowl 2025 will be conducted in accordance with standard 10-pin bowling rules.
- Each team shall comprise four (4) bowlers.
 - All bowlers in the team event will play three (3) games.
 - The total team score will be the combined pinfall of all four (4) bowlers across the three (3) games.
 - Each female bowler in a team will receive a 7-pin handicap per game, which will be added to the team's total score.

TIE-BREAKER

- In the event that two or more teams are tied for first, second, or third placing, the tie shall be resolved by comparing the teams' highest single-game total pinfall across the three games (Game 1, Game 2, or Game 3).
- The team with the highest single-game score will be awarded the higher placing.
- If the tie persists after comparing the highest game, the next highest game shall be taken into consideration.
- Should the tie remain unresolved, the decision of the Organising Committee shall be final.

PROHIBITIONS

To ensure a safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment for all participants, the following prohibitions will apply throughout the duration of the National Day Fun Bowl 2025:

- Smoking and Alcohol Consumption are strictly prohibited within the bowling centre.
- Use of foul language, unsportsmanlike conduct, or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification.
- Bowlers must not interfere with other players' lanes or equipment.
- All participants are expected to respect the decisions of Organising Committee and adhere to the rules of play at all times.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to take appropriate disciplinary action against any participant who breaches the above guidelines.

DISPUTES

- In the event of any disagreement or contention during the tournament, bowlers are required to refer the matter directly to the Organising Committee.
- All appeals must be submitted immediately after the game in question, and no later than 15 minutes following the conclusion of the affected game.
- The Organising Committee will assess the situation and render a decision, which shall be final and binding. Bowlers are advised not to engage other participants in attempts to resolve disputes independently.

VERIFICATION OF SCORES

- At the end of each game, the team leader is required to verify and sign the official score sheet to confirm the accuracy of the team's scores.
- Once the score sheet has been signed, no further amendments or disputes regarding that game's scores will be entertained.
- It is the responsibility of each team leader to ensure that the scores are correctly recorded before signing.

BOWLERS ATTIRE

- All bowlers are required to be appropriately attired in sportswear and must wear proper bowling shoes throughout the tournament.
- Slippers, sandals, open-toe footwear, skirts, mini-skirts, shorts, and non-sporting attire (e.g. jeans, sleeveless tops, or office wear) are strictly not permitted.
- Bowlers are encouraged to wear team uniforms or coordinated outfits where possible, to promote team identity and professionalism.

OTHERS

- While reasonable precautions will be taken, the organiser will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of this tournament.
- The Organiser reserves the right to amend the Terms & Conditions set out in this prospectus at its sole discretion without prior notice.
